LSFN is a community of three distinct settlements, which are Frenchman's Head, Kejick Bay, and Whitefish Bay. Their communities are found on the southeast shores of Lac Seul Lake and extends to the southward to the north shores of Lost Lake

Directions from Sioux Lookout: Go South on Hwy #72 (towards Dryden) approximately 10KM, then turn right on Hwy #664 go approximately 30KM to Frenchman's Head.

From Sioux Lookout to the Lac Seul Centre, it is another 40 KM (25 minutes).
