AIAI will be discussing the importance of empowering First Nations peoples through community based governance initiatives and how these initiatives encourage transparency and accountability to First Nation citizens.

Grand Chief Peters will also take this opportunity to discuss the lack of transparency and accountability from the Harper government and it's paternalistic attitude of "Do as I say, not as I do" towards First Nations.
