As part of the National Procurement Strategy to Address Wrecked, Abandoned, and Hazardous Vessels (the National Procurement Strategy), Canada is inviting you to respond to the next [Request for Information](https://buyandsell.gc.ca/procurement-data/tender-notice/PW-MER-002-27864) posted to buyandsell.gc.ca (<https://buyandsell.gc.ca/procurement-data/tender-notice/PW-MER-002-27864>). The new Request For Information includes questions to better understand the service options available for the disposal of vessels in an environmentally sound manner, which will help with the development of an Environmental Strategy. Your feedback would be greatly appreciated. Thank you to all who replied to the initial Request For Information for the National Procurement Strategy.

While Canada is seeking input from the general public on this Request For Information by September 8, 2020, **Canada is pleased to accept responses to the Request For Information from Indigenous partners any time up to September 18, 2020.**

If you have not already done so, we are still asking to please let us know if you are interested in reviewing the draft Request for Supply Arrangements for Marine Assessment Services and/or draft Request for Supply Arrangements for Vessel Disposal Services, as we will share the drafts with interested parties for their comment prior to issuing the Request for Supply Arrangements.

While there are no immediate plans for further Requests for Information under the National Procurement Strategy, this may change if further service requirements are identified which need a corresponding national procurement tool. You will be notified of any subsequent Requests for Information.
